Proficiency in a Learning Management System is also required, consistent with University guidelines.

Master of Social Work (MSW Program) -to teach research courses both in person and online. Qualifications: Master's degree in Social Work from a CSWE accredited program is required. Preferred qualifications include: a Doctorate degree in Social Work or a related field; Social Work licensure; Clinical Social Work licensure; at least two years of post-master's clinical social work practice experience; and experience teaching social work micro practice courses, along with experience teaching online.
