The post holder should also have excellent communication and proven leadership skills. Academic rank will be commensurate with qualifications and experience. Priority will be given to applicants at the Associate Professor or Professor level.

Its Department of Psychology has an established clinical psychology training programme, with excellent training facilities including an internal clinic and hospital and community partners with strong international collaborations.
