The University of Kansas seeks a tenure-track assistant professor in Urban Planning and Public Affairs. This position is a full-time, academic year appointment. The faculty member will participate in the teaching mission of the Urban Planning Program, including teaching core courses at the master's level; conduct research in urban planning leading to publication in appropriate media and to external funding as appropriate; and engage in unit, College, University, and national service. Ph.D., ABD, or terminal degree is expected by the start date of appointment. The successful candidate for the position must be eligible to work in the U.S. prior to the start of the position.

The ideal candidate will be able to create linkages that reflect our program's commitment to issues of diversity, equity and inclusion, and will have interests and expertise in transportation planning or housing and community development planning. Candidates should be capable of teaching at least one of our core courses, contributing to one or more areas within the program's specializations (Transportation, Housing and Development, and Sustainable Land Use), and contributing to interdisciplinary initiatives beyond the program.
