**Job Description**

Extension agents are professional educators who serve as a link between Kansas State University and communities across Kansas. This position will provide primary leadership for the development and implementation of research-based educational programming to build healthy, sustainable communities, families and individuals. Programming will be conducted with volunteers, other community development and family and consumer sciences professionals and state and area extension faculty. Programming may include strengthening families and individuals, community goal setting, family and community health and wellness, the PRIDE Program, and local volunteer development.

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Bachelor's degree with knowledge of family and consumer sciences as evidenced by academic courses, professional development and/or professional experience.

Evidence of strong academic and/or professional performance as documented by college transcripts, acceptance into a graduate program or documented success in increasingly responsible professional positions.
