The Department of Social Science & Policy Studies (SSPS) at Worcester Polytechnic Institute (WPI) invites applications for the non-tenure track position of assistant teaching professor in the Society, Technology, and Policy (STP) program. The new faculty member will serve in a leadership role for the program and teach courses in and advise STP students. This position will begin in summer 2019. WPI and SSPS are committed to building and supporting a multi-cultural and otherwise diverse educational community, with an active focus on diversifying the faculty, staff, and students.

#### JOB DESCRIPTION

At WPI, many students select the STP degree as a double major/minor option to complement one of WPI's STEM disciplines. The course work is broad in an effort to create graduates who are technically literate and able to translate complex scientific, policy, and regulatory information to varied audiences.

SSPS seeks candidates who have expertise in international relations, comparative politics, and/or public policy. Additional expertise in the areas of science/technology policy and/or environmental issues is also valued. They should be able to teach undergraduate courses in American government, public policy, international politics with expertise in science, technology, and environmental policy. In addition, all WPI faculty are expected to participate and advise students in the university's unique undergraduate projects program.

We seek individuals with a Ph.D. in political science, public policy, global public policy or a cognate discipline. The successful candidate will join a unified department of social scientists that has seven different program areas: (1) economics, (2) global public health, (3) international development, environment, and sustainability, (4) learning sciences and technologies, (5) psychology, (6) STP, and (7) system dynamics. In addition, SSPS has many course offerings and faculty members whose work focuses on issues of social justice, both in the department and across campus.

The assistant teaching professor position is for one year, with a potential for a second year renewal. Applications should include the following information in their application materials: (1) a cover letter outlining experience with teaching, scholarship/expertise, service, and commitment to/experience with diversity, equity, and inclusion; (2) a vitae; (3) a statement of teaching philosophy and inclusive methods used to reach diverse populations; (4) evidence of teaching effectiveness; and (5) contact information for three professional references. The review of applications will begin immediately and will remain open until the successful candidate has been identified.
