At the BSW level, courses are focused on generalist social work practice. They may include practice courses focused on individuals, families, or groups, as well as policy, research, or introduction to social work. More information about the BSW curriculum can be found here.

At the MSW level, we prepare students to become clinical social workers. Course work covers both generalist (foundation) level, as well as advanced clinical (more specialized) social work courses. Courses are practice-, theory-, assessment-, policy-, and/or research-related. More information about the MSW curriculum can be found here.

The DSW program prepares social work faculty for University level teaching and leadership. Course work includes content in research, scholarship, teaching, writing for publication, history of social work education and programming, dissertation work, and specific elective classes focusing on grant writing and leadership.
