The Health Sciences Librarian develops and delivers library and research support to faculty, students, administrators, staff, and others in three colleges within the *Macon & Joan Brock Virginia Health Sciences* at Old Dominion University (VHS): Ellmer College of Health Sciences, Ellmer School of Nursing, and the Joint School of Public Health. Duties include providing research assistance, instruction, collection development support, and assistance with scholarly communication to academic departments.

The Librarian serves as the subject specialist and primary contact person between the Libraries and departments, programs, and research centers to which they are assigned.
