A Ph.D. in Sociology or a closely related field is required by the date of appointment or shortly thereafter. The successful candidate will be expected to conduct innovative research at the highest international level and establish an outstanding, externally funded research program. She/he will have an emerging record of scholarly accomplishments and will provide evidence of excellence in research as demonstrated by presentations at significant conferences, awards for work in the field, strong endorsements by referees of high international standing, and publications in top ranked and field relevant academic journals and/or with leading academic presses. Candidates also must demonstrate a commitment to excellence in teaching and the ability to teach courses in quantitative methods, computational sociology and/or social statistics. Evidence of a commitment to excellence in teaching will be demonstrated through teaching evaluations, strong endorsements from referees, teaching accomplishments, and the teaching dossier submitted as part of the application. The successful candidate will contribute to the University's commitment to equity and diversity.
