The applicant must have a Ph.D. or equivalent from a recognized academic institution and preferably some postdoctoral experience. We will consider applicants from a wide range of academic disciplines although we are particularly interested in scholars who have international experience and are applied policy researchers. The successful applicant will have a strong interest in working with practitioners, as well as establishing research collaborations with other units at UD that have environmental research interests. Tenure track faculty are expected to produce high impact peer-reviewed research, and for this position an existing record of peer-reviewed publications and experience in securing externally funded research is strongly preferred. Successful applicants will teach undergraduate and graduate courses and supervise graduate students. The applicant should also be committed to establishing research collaborations with various other units on campus that have environmental research interests. The Delaware Environment Institute web site (denin.udel.edu) provides a synthesis of various environmental research opportunities across campus.
